

Subsequently, students are reminded that backpacks, duffle bags and similar items will not be permitted past the main entrance security desk. Likewise, students will be required to tag and surrender their cell phones upon arriving to their assigned testing locations. Upon completing their exams, students can retrieve their cell phones.

Lastly, please be advised that all lockers will be secured at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 8. **Therefore, students should remove all belongings from their lockers prior to the end of the day on Friday, June 8.** With that in mind, students are also reminded to return all school issued items (textbooks, calculators, uniforms, etc.) to the appropriate staff member.
