Dear Parents / Guardians and Student:

I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the warm weather and summer. With the close of another school year behind us, it behooves us to prepare for the upcoming school year to get a head start with various school related events.

The purpose of this communication is to provide you with preliminary information regarding the **2019 Senior Class Trip to Disney World, Florida**. We have contracted with Curriculum Travel of America (CTA) to coordinate the itinerary and accommodations for next year's trip.

The above said, the Senior Trip to Orlando, Florida, is tentatively scheduled for March 13 – 17, 2019. The approximate cost of the trip is \$1,889.00 per student. In order to reserve airfare, students need to register and submit a **\$400 deposit to CTA by Monday, September 17, 2018**. Log on to:

- www.CTAfieldtrips.com
- Click on "Register/Make Trip Payment"
- Enter Trip Code "**CW9ME**" (no quotes; case sensitive)
- Complete the forms and use your credit card to make the payment

Payments can be made directly through Curriculum Travel of America online or via mail. Students will be assigned a seat on the plane upon receipt of the aforementioned deposit. All subsequent payments will be made directly to CTA as well. While the due date for the deposit is still a few weeks away, this advanced notice provides students with some time to prepare for the payment due dates should they wish to partake in the trip. All information pertaining to the trip will be posted on the high school's website.

The Senior Class advisors and officers will continue to work with CTA representatives to prepare an itinerary that should be looked upon favorably by the class and maintain students' safety while traveling and touring. A **tentative** itinerary with the approximate payment schedule is enclosed for your reference. Airfare, rooming accommodations, meals (4), and all activities on the itinerary are included in the cost of the trip.

Lastly, an informational meeting for students and parents is tentatively scheduled for February 8, 2019.
