NEW ACT PREP CLASS AT HIGH SCHOOL

Beginning in November 2017, Mt. Sinai High School will be offering an ACT prep course for sophomores and juniors. The course will be held at the high school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7-9 p.m. A flyer will be mailed home with more information about registration and dates.

The course is being taught through Method Test Prep and will be designed to prepare students for the December ACT.

The course is designed to support individual learning styles, and taught by top teachers. These courses can also improve overall study skills and achievement.

Method Test Prep gives students the opportunity to get support from qualified test prep experts. Geared towards students who are taking the ACT exam for the first time, these classes give the students the preparation they need to get a better score.

The ACT course will cover the critical reading, math, writing, and science concepts that students need to improve.
