

PESTICIDE APPLICATION NOTICE

The Mount Sinai School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48 hour prior written notice of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements:

- anti-microbial products
- nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- silica gel and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children
- boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate
- the application of EPA-designated biopesticides
- the application of EPA-designated exempt materials under 40 CFR § 152.25
- the use of aerosol products individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets

In additions, there will be no written notice of such application when a school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good-faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list.
