BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Mount Sinai Union Free School District, Suffolk County, New York, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell not exceeding \$14,000,000 tax anticipation notes of the Mount Sinai Union Free School District, Suffolk County, New York, including renewals thereof, in anticipation of the collection of taxes levied or to be levied for the fiscal year of said School District commencing

July 1, 2020, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education of said School District, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said President of the Board of Education, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

## 5. Budget - Proposition I

Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education hereby adopts the following proposition (Budget) to be voted upon at the June 9, 2020 Annual Meeting:

SHALL the proposed budget of expenditures of the Mount Sinai Union Free School District for the fiscal year 2020-21 in the amount of \$61,769,870 for the purposes shown in the statement thereof presented to and at the Budget Hearing of said School District be approved and the amount thereof raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property within said School District after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources as provided by law.

### 6. Library Services - Proposition II

Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education hereby adopts the following proposition (Library Services) to be voted upon at the June 9, 2020 Annual Meeting:

RESOLVED, that for the purpose of enabling the people of this District to have the benefit of library services, the Board of Education of the Mount Sinai Union Free School District shall contract with the Comsewogue Public Library and the Port Jefferson Free Library for library services commencing July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 in the amount of \$1,762,292, a tax is hereby voted in such amount to be levied upon the taxable property of the District.

### 7. <u>Capital Project – Proposition III</u>

Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education hereby adopts the following proposition (Capital Project) to be voted upon at the June 9, 2020 Annual Meeting:

SHALL the Board of Education of the Mount Sinai UFSD be authorized to appropriate and expend from the Capital Reserve Fund established on May 15, 2018, an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 for the purpose of undertaking school building improvement projects to commence during the 2020-21 school year and to consist of the construction of improvements and alterations to the Mount Sinai High School; the Mount Sinai Middle School; and the Mount Sinai Elementary School as follows: completion of the High School roof replacement; replacement of the High School basement pipe valves; replacement of the Middle School water heater; installation of the Middle School and Elementary School Americans with Disabilities compliant bathrooms; and replacement of the Elementary School hot water tank; and other work required in connection therewith; including preliminary costs, site work and costs incidental to the reconstruction.

#### 8. Real Property Tax Report Card

Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education hereby approves the Real Property Tax Report Card prepared by the District's business office for the 2020 Annual District Meeting; and Be It Further Resolved that a copy of said report card shall be submitted to the State Education Department by the end of the next business day following this approval.
