**ANNUAL BUDGET & BOARD OF EDUCATION VOTE  
June 9, 2020 (counting of ballots June 16, 2020)**

At 5:00 p.m., Maureen Poerio, Chief Election Inspector, ordered that the absentee oath envelopes be opened and the counting of ballots for the Budget (Proposition I), Library Services (Proposition II), Capital Project (Proposition III) and election of three Trustees of the Board of Education commenced.

SHALL the proposed budget of expenditures of the Mount Sinai Union Free School District for the fiscal year 2020-21 in the amount of \$61,769,870 for the purposes shown in the statement thereof presented to and at the Budget Hearing of said School District be approved and the amount thereof raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property within said School District after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources as provided by law.

**PROPOSITION APPROVED**

RESOLVED, that for the purpose of enabling the people of this District to have the benefit of library services, the Board of Education of the Mount Sinai Union Free School District shall contract with the Comsewogue Public Library and the Port Jefferson Public Library for library services starting July 1, 2020 and running through June 30, 2021 in the amount of \$1,762,292 and that a tax is hereby voted in such amount to be levied upon the taxable property of the District.

**PROPOSITION APPROVED**

SHALL the Board of Education of the Mount Sinai UFSD be authorized to appropriate and expend from the Capital Reserve Fund established on May 15, 2018, an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 for the purpose of undertaking school building improvement projects to commence during the 2020-21 school year and to consist of the construction of improvements and alterations to the Mount Sinai High School; the Mount Sinai Middle School; and the Mount Sinai Elementary School as follows: completion of the High School roof replacement; replacement of the High School basement pipe valves; replacement of the Middle School water heater; installation of the Middle School and Elementary School Americans with Disabilities compliant bathrooms; and replacement of the Elementary School hot water tank; and other work required in connection therewith; including preliminary costs, site work and costs incidental to the reconstruction.
