What Is UPK?

- Allows Children the opportunity to attend a well-designed, high-quality Pre-K program.
- Stepping stone to Kindergarten readiness.
- Funding through NYS grant for the sole purpose of providing Pre-K.
- The Aid is limited and can only be used on a pre-determined number of students. State guidelines do not allow for the funds to be used in any other manner.

Program at Mt Sinai

- Mount Sinai introduced the program two years ago
- In collaboration with SCOPE
- Curriculum based on NYS Learning Standards for Pre-school age children.

Program Operation

- Full-Day program
- The 3 classrooms will be in Mount Sinai Elementary School
- Classes are Monday through Friday 9:30 to 2:30
- The child attends 5 hours per day, 5 days per week
- The PreK Program Follows the District Calendar
- Students may bring their lunch or purchase their lunch through the lunch program
- Parents provide the transportation and are required to sign the child in and out of the program each day
